

2022 Warren County Prime Beef Festival Hog Show

Monday, September 5th, 2022 - Warren County Fairgrounds (Roseville)

Check in at 12:00 pm, show begins promptly at 2:00 pm

Two Divisions: Festival & Jr Open

Festival Division Rules:

- Ownership Deadline: July 1st
- Pig must not have been shown by anyone but the exhibitor or their immediate family member at any other show
- Gilts will show with barrows
- Top four pigs will sell in the Livestock Auction

Jr Open Rules:

- Ownership Deadline: August 15th
- Gilts will show with Barrows
- Top four pigs will sell in the Livestock Auction

General Hog Show Rules:

- Entry Deadline: **Sunday, September 4th, 2022**; please contact a Swine Committee Member with how many pigs you are bringing so we know when everyone has arrived and we can close the scale
- Open to any person 21 years old and younger who lives in Warren County or attends a Warren County School District
- Exhibitors must be present to show their pig
- Weight limit: 230 - 300 lbs
- \$5 entry fee per pig (deducted from check)
- Non-terminal show
- Pigs are released after show
- No limit to the number of entries per exhibitor, but they may only sell one pig in the Livestock Auction
- If an exhibitor has more than one pig qualify for the Livestock Auction, they will choose which pig they want to sell. The other qualifying pig will be scratched and the pig immediately following it in class will replace it in the Livestock Auction. If that exhibitor already has a pig in the Livestock Auction, the next highest placing pig will be selected
- Exhibitors are expected to attend the Livestock Auction
- Eight (8) pigs will be sold in the Livestock Auction with a buyback option for the purchaser
- Exhibitors are responsible for making arrangements with the processor if the buyer chooses to have the pig processed
- Exhibitors must clean their pens or premium monies will be withheld
