Steer Show Rules

- The show is open to any boy or girl who lives in Warren County or attends a Warren County School as of January 1st of the year the Festival is held
- Animals shown in the steer show must be the property of the boy or girl showing them, weighed-in at their local 4-H or FFA weigh-in day, and shown at the a local 4-H, FFA, or State Fair
- All entries must be on the grounds by 10:00 am
- All steers shown are to be terminated at the conclusion of the sale
- Every animal upon the grounds and entered for premiums will, during the festival, be under the control of the Beef Committee. All possible care of animals will be taken by committee but the committee will in no case be responsible for any damages that may occur
- A premium will not be awarded for the animal to be thought not worthy, although there be no competition
- All animals must comply with State of Illinois health rules
- All animals must be shown to receive a premium
- All animals must be entered in their proper class
- All animals must be shown by the exhibitor
- No exhibitor will be allowed more than one entry in the singles classes
- No feeding of animals will be allowed on the grounds outside of the buildings
- No paper bedding will be allowed
- Awards will be made by a qualified judge
- The Beef Committee has the right to reject any animal showing signs of disease

Additional Rules & Regulations for the Prime Beef Festival Steer Show

- All steer entries must be made by Friday, August 26th, 2022; a late entry will be charged an office fee of \$12/entry
- There will be no entries accepted after September 4th, 2022
- No entry refund to non-winners
- All entries must be accompanied by full payment of entry fee
- The Beef Committee reserves the right to reject any or all disputes
- The decision of the Beef Committee will be final in all disputes
- Any exhibitor who, upon the suggestion of the Beef Committee, shall be found guilty of finding fault with the decision of the judge, can be excluded from exhibiting
- No person shall act as judge in any class which they are an exhibitor
- All protests must be in writing and a \$25 deposit must accompany it
- Trophies, plaques, or ribbons may be awarded at the discretion of the Beef Committee
- There will be no tie outs
